Make reading a social activity by forming a variety of book clubs that focus on reading genres. Form clubs of 4 or 5 students, and then assign a reading genre to each club. Students research books in their assigned genres to create reading lists. Each student chooses a book to read, and then writes a short review to share with the entire class. Designate a special time for book reviews each week. Your bulletin board display will show the books to be reviewed. Kids will enjoy learning from each other and discovering new kinds of books to read!
